OF CORNWALL-ON-HUDSON SETTING A TIME AND PLACE
FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON A PROPOSED LOCAL LAW TO
AMEND THE VILLAGE CODE PROHIBITING PARKING ON
PORTIONS OF CHURCH STREET AND DUNCAN AVENUE**

WHEREAS, prohibiting parking on certain portions of Church Street and Duncan Avenue will allow traffic to flow more safely and is in the overall public interest; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board wishes to set a time and place for a public hearing to consider the adoption of an amendment to Chapter 155-48 of the Village Code prohibiting parking on a portion of Church Street and Duncan Avenue;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY

RESOLVED, that the Village Board hereby determines that it will be the lead agency with respect to the review of the proposed local law (the “project”) in accord with New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (“SEQRA”) and part 617 of the regulations implementing SEQRA, since there are no other agencies that have the authority to approve the project; and let it be further

RESOLVED, that the Village Board hereby classifies the action as an unlisted action under SEQRA; and let it be further

RESOLVED, that a public hearing be held by the Village Board in order to receive comments and suggestions regarding the proposed amendment to the local law to prohibiting parking on a portion of Church Avenue and Duncan Road, and to receive any comments concerning the potential adverse environmental impacts of the proposed legislation in accord with SEQRA, on March 19, 2012, at 7:01 p.m. at the Village Hall located at 325 Hudson Street, Cornwall-on-Hudson, New York; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause said public notice of said hearing to be given as provided by law.
