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Village Summer Recreation Program starts July 5

The Village of Cornwall-on-Hudson will operate its Summer Recreation Program for six weeks, from July 5 through Aug. 10.

The program runs from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Monday through Friday at Cornwall-on-Hudson elementary school.

The program is open to children who will enter grades K-6 next autumn.

The recreation program offers games, sports, arts and crafts, swimming, special activities and field trips.

Registration will be held from 10 a.m. to noon June 9 and from 6-8 p.m. June 18 in the village hall board room. Parents and guardians must bring a form of identification indicating their address. They must also bring an up-to-date immunization record from the their children's health provider.

Jennifer Borland is returning as director and Jenna Park is returning as assistant director. The program will be seeking counselors; the deadline for applications is May 25. Counselors must be at least 16 years old and must attend a two-hour training course. The program will also be seeking a health director this year.

The fee for Cornwall-on-Hudson residents is \$150 per child (\$325 maximum per family). The fee for non-village residents is \$250 per child. Field trips will require additional fees.
